During the final hours of the Baby Shower, we hold the Diaper Dash. It is a diaper collection blitz, broadcast live over KYCC, during which participating communities compete to see which can collect the most diapers for their local pregnancy center. Last year, the Diaper Dash netted a total of 45,441

diapers; the Pregnancy Resource Center of Tracy was the winning collection location with 11,260 diaper donations. This year, the Diaper Dash will be held on Friday, January 22, from 3 to 6 p.m.

KYCT, Ruidoso Tower Falls

During a severe wind and snow storm in early December, the mountaintop communications tower supporting the KYCT antenna blew over, taking the station off the air. The tower collapse also damaged the building, at the base of the tower, that houses the KYCT transmitting equipment. Miraculously, very little of the station's equipment was damaged. Even the antenna on the fallen tower survived! KYCT, at 91.3 FM, rebroadcasts KYCC programming to Ruidoso, New Mexico, and the surrounding areas. The station is also rebroadcast over KYCC's translator at 92.5 FM in Roswell, New Mexico. Arrangements for getting the station and the translator back on the air are still being made.
